Prerequisites** Candidates applying for a postgraduate echocardiography training fellowship should have at least Level 1 training and preferably Level II training, according to the standards set by the Canadian Cardiovascular Society or the American Society of Echocardiography.

Program Description

- A. Duration of fellowship program: 12 months.
- B. Research opportunities: many research opportunities are available, including but not limited to the following fields: heart failure, cardiac resynchronization, valvular heart disease, imaging for percutaneous valvular procedures and congenital heart disease.
- C. Number of echocardiographers: 10
- D. Machines: the echocardiography laboratory is equipped with seven Vivid-7 echocardiography machines and one Vivid-1 portable machine.
- E. Number of sonographers: 11
- F. Volume of examinations per year:
 - I. Transthoracic echocardiograms: from 10 000 to 11 000
 - II. Transesophageal echocardiograms: 1 100
 - III. Stress echocardiograms: from 400 to 500
