Applicant Qualifications / Prerequisites These positions are intended for individuals that are qualified for educational or practice license in Canada, completed clinical cardiology training, and are interested in pursuing an academic career in echocardiography.

Program Description The University of Alberta Hospital, Division of Cardiology, offers a 12-24 month, Royal College accredited, area of focused competence (AFC), clinical Echocardiography Fellowship to meet Level 3 training standards, as defined by the Canadian Cardiovascular Society. During this period, trainees would be expected to participate in transthoracic, transesophageal echocardiography, as well as stress/dobutamine echocardiography training. In addition, a clinical research project is a mandatory component of this training.
