The Ottawa Cardiovascular Centre announces ongoing recruitment of community based clinical cardiologists. The qualified candidate will be proposed for hospital privileges at the General Campus of the Ottawa Hospital or the Montfort Hospital.

This is a fee for service opportunity and not salaried employment. Estimated office derived income is expected to be approximately \$300,000 to \$400,000 depending on workload and time allocation between office and hospital activity. Average office derived income \$350,000. Hospital derived income should be roughly equivalent.

Ottawa Cardiovascular Centre- Practice Description 2021

The Ottawa Cardiovascular Centre (OCC) offers comprehensive cardiovascular care to a registered patient population of over 275,000 patients with approximately 50,000 active patients. Originally founded in 1987 by Drs. Joel Niznick and Brendan Quinn, OCC has grown to a 8 cardiologist group. As well OCC has integrated a 2 Pediatric Cardiologists, 5 Internists and 1 Endocrinologist into the practice to deal with the broader aspects of residual cardiovascular risk management. We provide Cardiology Consultation, Rapid Referral Clinic, Residual Risk Clinic, cardiovascular risk assessment and management and long term cardiovascular follow-up to optimize cardiovascular outcomes. We provide on-site cardiovascular non-invasive testing at two sites. Our catchment area extends from Alexandria to Deep River and the Quebec border to the St Lawrence River. Annually we provide upward of 50,000 patient interactions within the broad spectrum of cardiovascular disease. In addition, we provide more than 30,000 diagnostic tests annually.

On-site available testing includes:

- Stress Testing – 2 dedicated Treadmill Stress/Persantine Stress Labs
- Echo/Doppler – 4 GE Vivid E90s, 2 GE Vivid E9s, 3 GE Vivid 7s, 1 GE Vivid S6

- Cardiac Loop Recorders – CARDIOPHONE wireless real time monitoring
- Ambulatory BP Monitoring
- Exercise stress myocardial perfusion imaging
- Persantine stress myocardial perfusion imaging


Our main office comprises 14,500 square feet- newly refurbished and expanded with 20 examination rooms, conference room, 4 stress labs, 2 nuclear labs and 9 echocardiography labs including a dedicated bicycle ergometer stress echocardiography laboratory. Our satellite office comprises approximately 3000 square feet including 6 examination rooms, one stress lab, 2 echo labs and one nuclear lab.
